

Resolution 9-2018, May 21st, 2018

Holmes City Township

Snow and Ice Removal Policy

BE IT RESOLVED that plowing of snow from Holmes City Township roads, paved or unpaved, shall commence at the discretion of the Township Supervisors and/or the Primary Equipment Operator, but not before a minimum of three (3) inches of snow accumulation. Start time may vary due to conditions or Equipment Operator availability. The final decision to begin plowing, and/or delay operations for snow and ice removal, shall be made by a designated Supervisor based upon the current, and anticipated, weather conditions.

Miscellaneous Policy Stipulations:

1. This policy may be changed or modified at any time by the Holmes City Township Board of Supervisors, or in an emergency, by the Primary Equipment Operator.
2. The Holmes City Township Board of Supervisors has ordered that there be no plowing of private driveways using township equipment.
3. The Holmes City Township Board of Supervisors has ordered that the Equipment Operators not become involved with the towing or pulling of any non-township vehicles. The only exception to this order is that the Equipment Operators may assist a stranded motorist where concerns for personal safety is involved.
4. The Equipment Operators will plow the roads currently listed in the town line agreements with adjacent townships.
