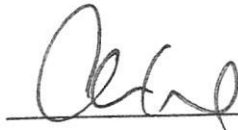
Culverts and Approaches Policy

BE IT RESOLVED by the Holmes City Board of Supervisors that all driveways and approaches meeting a township road must meet the following requirements:

1. Install a galvanized steel culvert of not less than 15 inches in diameter unless determined by a Supervisor that a smaller diameter will be sufficient, or one is not required.
2. All culverts on Holmes City Township driveways and approaches will be paid for by the abutting owner.
3. Driveways and approaches must have a top surface of not less than 20 feet and a slope of not steeper than 4 to 1.
4. Culvert must be installed so that the bottom of the culvert is at grade level or slightly lower.
5. Filling or restricting natural drainage way within the township right-of-way is prohibited.
6. Prior to installation of a culvert or approach, contact a member of the Holmes City Board of Supervisors for approval of the location and construction.
7. A list of local suppliers of approved culverts will be provided upon request.
8. New driveway locations must be approved by a Supervisor.

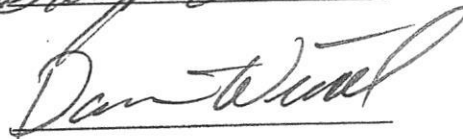
